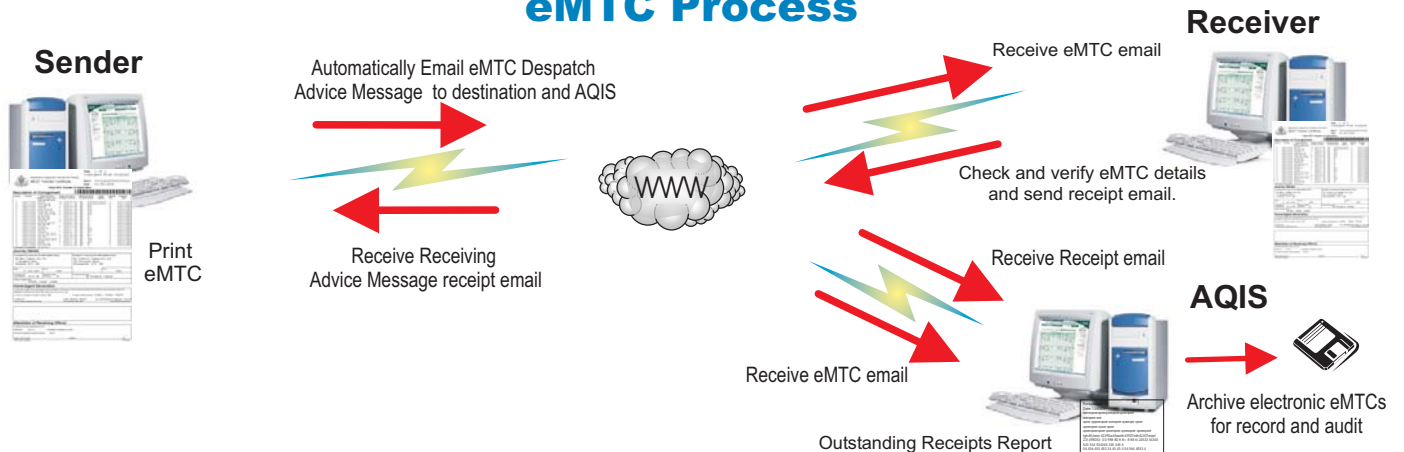


The Electronic Meat Transfer Certificates (eMTC) providing bio-Security, traceability and efficiency

The eMTC system is directly used by processors, cold storage facilities, shipping companies, exporters, importers, country of destination cold storage facilities and finally the buyers.

Indirectly the regulatory authorities use the eMTC to validate the details and contents of consignments by being able to verify each and every carton uniquely by reconciling the bar codes to the export documentation.

eMTC Process



Key Points

The eMTC system applies global standards to uniquely track and trace individual cartons of meat back to the country of origin and their production source. The eMTC system is built on the GS1 global trading standards for unique product identification (GS1 bar code) and electronic messaging (EANCOM despatch advice message).

The eMTC:

- key industry organisations such as AQIS, MLA, and AUS-MEAT have participated with the eMTC development

- has been developed and trialed with large and small industry participants to ensure suitability with existing on plant and trading partner systems
- the correctly implemented use of the eMTC system has demonstrated large savings within organisations by greatly reducing the manual paper work associated with the paper MTC forms
- the eMTC works in conjunction with EXDOC to uniquely identify each and every carton of product in a consignment
- the eMTC is a set of standards and business rules that can be built into existing establishment systems
